



TAHITI LIME DATA SHEET

Scientific Name: *Citrus latifolia tanaka*
Commercial Name: Tahiti Lime
Variety: Tahiti

Fruit oval or globe shape, with a slightly depressed apex, surmounted by a short nipple-shaped styler scar. The epicarp is made up of numerous oil glands and is characterized by its green color, reaching yellow tones in the absence of sun. It is seedless and its endocarp is juicy, acidic and fragrant.



Presentation: Fresh

Characteristics: Whole limes, with uniform shapes and touch resistance, homogeneous in variety and size, free of any smell, taste, or foreign material, free of damage, disease, bruises, scars, insects, bacteria or / and fungi that detract their quality.
