Alejo pulled a giant booger from his nose on the street. That was enough to ruin his life. He thought no one was watching, but someone recorded it and posted the video. In less than 36 hours, the image of him pulling a snot went viral. He became a meme, the laughingstock of school, the disgusting teenager in his neighborhood, an outcast. There were others like him in his neighborhood: ostracized teens, pariahs. Now that Alejo has become the “snot boy”, those kids he despised will become his greatest friends.

This 30-minute dramedy tells the misadventures and humiliations of five teenagers who have been on the receiving end of rumors, abuse, and cyberbullying. For an adult, becoming a meme or being the center of a rumor can be a pain. But for a teenager, public lynching by modern digital mobs can mark his life forever.

Pariahs is a dark comedy about ostracism, about those kids who are rejected by their peers and have to reinvent their lives in the fringes of their social groups. They are the freaks who come together out of necessity, since loneliness is painful and often dangerous for mental health. It is also a story about friendship. In difficult times, the only refuge for these kids is the friendship of those who have had similar experiences.
